

Water Pong



What you'll need

- 6 Plastic cups for each player
- Water for each cup
- A Ping Pong ball

How to play

1. Set out 6 cups in a triangle on either side of a table.
2. Fill the cups 1/3 with water.
3. Players stand on either side of the table behind the cups.
4. Players take turns attempting to throw the ball into the opposing player's cups.
5. Each time the ball goes in, that cup is then removed.
6. Once all cups are eliminated, the opposite player wins a prize!





Giant Lawn Bowls

What you'll need

- A large exercise ball or beach ball
- A “Jack” or Flag
- A Winner's Prize!

How to play

1. Players join teams of 5 or less.
2. Place a “Jack” on the lawn at a far point.
3. Teams select a player to bowl a large exercise ball aiming to get as close as possible to the Jack.
4. Once a player bowls they stand/sit on the lawn where their ball landed.
5. Teams take turns bowling for 5 rounds or until all have bowled and are standing/sitting on the lawn.
6. The player standing closest to the Jack wins a prize for their team.

Rule: If a player is hit by the bowling ball they are eliminated.



Passing the Torch



What you'll need

Chairs for each player

A "torch" for each team

A Winner's Prize!

How to play

1. Divide players into even teams.
2. Each player sits on a chair behind another player on their team creating a line of chairs for each team.
3. The first player in each team starts with the "torch".
4. On "Go", the first player passes the "torch" overhead to the next person in line.
5. Each subsequent player continues passing the "torch" down the line, ensuring it reaches the last person.
6. Once the last person receives the "torch", they then pass it back down the line to the first person.
7. The first team to complete the full circuit wins.



Olympic Torch Cupcakes



What you'll need

Icecream cones

Mini cupcakes

Icing

Red and orange lollies or fruit

How to create

1. Place a mini cupcake in an ice cream cone.
2. Ice the top of the cupcake generously.
3. Decorate the cupcake with red and orange flame-like lollies or fruit.
4. Enjoy!



Soccer Penalty Kick



What you'll need

A soft bouncy ball (Soccer ball sized)

Goal markers (This could be Flags, Chairs or Bins)

A Winner's Prize!

How to play

1. Divide players into even teams.
2. Teams wait together in an audience sitting area and cheer their team on.
3. Set up the goal markers a distance from the sitting area - give the goal markers 1-2 meters between them.
4. Players from each team take turns rolling or kicking the ball into the Goals. Players get 3 turns each before they return to the seating area.
5. Each time a ball goes through the goals their team gets a point.
6. The team with the most points once everyone has had their go wins a prize!
